



We anticipate that by the end of the fiscal year, NCYC '24 will have brought in \$878,352 in revenue with about \$1,573,144 in expenses.

That will result in a net deficit of \$694,793 for this amazing event. While this is not the result we had expected, the event produced a 20% increase in the number of attendees from NCYC '22. In the coming months, the Board will be developing a plan addressing the future of the Long Beach event.





## **Moving Forward**

While we still face challenges, our financial outlook continues to improve.

Early registrations for NCYC Indy '25 exceed our estimates. We are looking forward to a very successful event this fall. And we were recently awarded a \$5 million grant from the Lilly Foundation Inc. with additional grant opportunities in sight.

A development committee has been formed, and a development plan is underway to create an endowment that will support NFCYM for years to come.






